Finding the Course Descriptions/Syllabi on JCUS Website

To locate course descriptions/syllabi for JCUS courses, follow the instructions below:

1. Copy and paste the following link into a new tab/window in your browser:
<https://secure.jcu.edu.au/app/studyfinder/index.cfm?year=2010&text=BU1005&as=code&campus=&grad=&sp=&mode=&table=>
2. Begin by entering the following criteria:
 - **Search For:** Enter subject code from Course List above
 - **Campus:** Choose “JCU Singapore”
 - **Level:** “Undergraduate”
 - **Study Period:** “all SPs in teaching period 1 (Jan-June)” or “all SPs in teaching period 2 (July-Dec)”
 - Leave other fields blank and hit “**SEARCH**”

****When looking at where/when the subject is offered make note that JCUS runs on trimesters. Look for the following codes:**

SP51 = Spring (March)

SP52 = Summer (June)

SP53 = Fall (October)

Click on the course number or title to view description of class content and objectives.

Be sure you are viewing the classes offered at the **JCU Singapore Campus** as opposed to those of the main campus in Australia.
