The Study Abroad program enables you to study for one or two Trimesters (4 or 8 months), earning credits towards your home institution degree. As a study abroad student at our university you are able to choose subjects from a wide range of study areas that will add value to your degree and broaden your experience. This program is primarily offered to undergraduate students.

Study Areas

The Singapore Campus concentrates on specific areas of study in the following fields:

- **Business** – There are majors available for Bachelor of Business including Management, Marketing, International Business, Tourism Management and Hospitality Management.
- **Information Technology** – Our Bachelor of Information Technology is accredited by the Australian Computer Society at the 'Professional Level'. General English Language Requirement

If your native language is not English, you may be required to demonstrate your English proficiency by achieving a score in a recognized English test.

The minimum English language proficiency requirement for this program is:

- IELTS 6.0 (no component lower than 5.5)/TOEFL 550 (with a minimum written English test score of 4.0) and above; or
- Satisfactory completion of James Cook University English Language Preparatory Program (ELPP).
